

## 2nd COMPETITION FOR ILLUSTRATORS AND COMIC ARTISTS LUCCA JUNIOR 2008

**"Princess, Emperors and Mandarins. Giacomo Puccini's Turandot".**  
Special section dedicated to the artists from Eastern Europe.

Art.1. Lucca Junior calls an illustration competition in order to mount an exhibition on the occasion of the hundred fiftieth anniversary of the birth of the great Italian Composer Giacomo Puccini.

Art.2. The participation in the competition is free and does not provide age limit. The competition is subdivided into two sections: one for the Italian artists and a special one for the works of artists from Eastern Europe (Poland, Russia and countries from the ex Urss).

Art.3. Object of the competition is the creation of a plate suitable for children too. The participants guarantee the originality of their works. In case of selection of works already published the same works will be suspended from the competition.

Art.4. The participants will create a maximum A3 format plate (42x29,5 cm) using any technique on drawing paper or flexible cardboard or digital media. Bigger format plates, set in a passpartout or in any other kind of frame, won't be considered nor returned.

Art.5. In order to be selected the participants will send by e-mail their digital image in jpg format. In case of selection and to participate in the exhibition, the participant will send the original plate by mail or, if the selected works are digital, by e-mail or ftp.

Art.6. The participants must send by e-mail, containing personal information (first name, surname, address, title of the work, e-mail and telephone) their plate for a preselection, also attaching a short resumé. In case of selection the back of the original plate must contain personal information.

Art.8. The works will be selected by a jury, chaired by Professor Livio Sossi (lecturer of Literature for Children at the University of Udine) and composed by experts and personalities in this field. The Jury's choices will be unquestionable.

Art.9. Those worthy works selected by the Jury will take part in the Exhibition mounted in Lucca, on the occasion of the festival "Lucca Comics & Games" (30th October - 2nd November 2008).



Art.10. The Jury will declare the winner, whose prize is the journey and the hospitality in Lucca on the occasion of the festival.

Art.11. The exhibition and the prizegiving will take place during the Junior Section's happenings on the occasion of the festival "Lucca Comics & Games".

Art.12. The winner plate won't be returned, but it will become part of a travelling exhibition to repose during other festivals in Italy and abroad.

Art.13. The participants release the organization from any responsibility connected with all those matters including damage, theft, fire of the works during the transportation and the exhibition.

Art.14. The authors authorize the organization to reproduce their works on catalogues, posters, leaflets and any kind of useful support to promote the Exhibition. In any of these cases the organization will always mention the authors.

Art.15. The participation in the competition implies the unconditional acceptance of the rules. It is up to the managers of the organization a final decision concerning any controversy.
